

SERMON.

The Rev. Dr. David Gregg on "Effectiveness in Personal Work."

In the Lafayette Avenue Presbyterian Church, Brooklyn, the pastor, the Rev. Dr. David Gregg, recently delivered a sermon on Personal Evangelism. His special subject was "Effectiveness in Personal Work."

The mission of Christians in the world is self-evident. Their name reveals it. It is this: To be a Christ in the community and to do Christ's work. As Christians we have been saved that we may save others.

While this is the purpose of our reigning God, yet we ourselves must fulfill our own mission and do our own work. God will co-operate with us, but he will not take our place, nor do that which we neglect to do.

Are we taking the world for Christ as rapidly as we should? IS EVERY ONE AT WORK and at work in downright earnest? Are you at work, and are you satisfying yourself with your work?

How often during these latter times do we hear discussions concerning the "lapsed masses." And how often is the question asked, "Why have the masses lapsed from the church?"

My friends, we talk of the unconquered and of their duty of repentance. I will tell you the story of the salvation of the morning. "Some Requester for Effectiveness in Personal Work for the Master."
