

TRADE INSTRUCTOR, VETCRAFT, GRADE 2.

DEFINITION OF CLASS:

Under direction, to supervise the work of a number of employees engaged in the manufacture of Vetcraft products; to lay out work; to design and construct patterns; to prepare requisitions for supplies and generally to promote the efficiency of the personnel.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Primary school and preferably high school education, with at least six years of experience in the wood working trade, three years of which shall have been in supervisory capacity in a large factory; experience in design, construction and assembly work and of modern wood working machinery; tact; good judgment and ability to handle men.

COMPENSATION:

Annual: \$1860 1980 2100

Note: Employees in this class shall receive such rate in the salary range as may be determined by the Civil Service Commission after consultation with the Department.
