a Member of this House, and one of the Representatives for the County of Hants, bs vacated, for absenting himself from this House during the whole of the last and prefent Seilion.

Resolved, That Mr. Speaker do take the usual steps for procuring a new Writ for the election of a Member to represent the County of Hants, aforefaid.

Mr. Robie reported from the Committee of Privileges, on the fubject of the Seat of Foster Hutchinson, Esq. Representative of the Town of Halifax; and he read the report in his place, and afterwards delivered it in at the Clerk's Table, where it was read, and is as follows :

That the committee have taken the subject into confideration, and beg leave to report, that by a Statute of this Province, made the last Sessions of the General Astenbly, it was declared, that it should not be lawful for any Assistant Justice of the Supreme Court to hold, poffeis, or enjoy, any other office, post, place, appointment, or fituation, except the office of Mafter in Chancery, or that of a Member of His Majesty's Council; that, fince the passing the faid Act, the faid Foster Hutchinson hath been appointed an Affistant Justice of the Supreme Court, which office he hath accepted, and now holds; and that it appears to the committee, that the Seat of the faid Foster Hutchinson ought to be declared vacant, it being the intention of the faid Act that no Judge of the faid Court fhould hold a Seat in the House of Affembly; and thereupon,

Resolved, That the Seat of Foster Hutchinson, Esq. a Member of this House, and one of the Representatives for the Town of Halifax, be vacated.

Refolved, That Mr. Speaker do take the usual steps for procuring a new Writ for the election of a Member to represent the Town of Halifax aforefaid.

On motion, the House resolved itself into a Committee of the whole House, on the further confideration of a Supply.

Mr Speaker left the Chair.

Mr. Puol took the Chair.

Mr. Speaker refumed the Chair. The Chairman reported from the Committee, that they had gone through the bufinefs to them referred, and that the committee had come to leveral refolutitions thereupon, upon which they had framed a Bill for applying certain Monies therein mentioned for the fervice of the prefent year, and he read the report in his place, and afterwards delivered the Bill in at the Clerk's Table, where the refolutions and claufes were feverally read throughout a first and fecond time; and, upon the question put thereupon, agreed to by the House. 

On motion, the faid Bill was read a first time,

Resolved, That the faid Bill be now read a fecond time, and the fame was read a fecond time accordingly. 

Ordered, Ihat the Bill be engroffed.

Resolved, That Mr. Speaker be requested to inform his Excellency the Lieutenant. Governor, that it will be more convenient to the Members if the Affembly could be called as early as the twentieth of January, and to express the wifh of the House, that if it is not perfonally inconvenient to Pis Excellency, and does not interfere with His Majefty's Service, that he would be pleafed to call the Houfe at that time.
