They are dying, they are dying Where the golden corn is growing...

from eight and a half millions of men to four and a half millions now in the reign of Queen Victoria...

THE RICHER PARTS OF IRELAND HAVE BEEN MADE DESOLATE

Why, there is no race in the world which, I believe, by instinct is more inclined to sentiments of loyalty than the Irish. Why do not these English statesmen give us something to be loyal to?

IN IRELAND THERE IS NEITHER LIBERTY, PROSPERITY, NOR LOYALTY (hear, hear). There is oppression and poverty and misgovernment, and deep-seated and justifiable disloyalty...

THE SKELETON AT YOUR FEAST (loud applause) You cannot disguise from the world that one portion of that Empire—and a portion which, all things considered, had probably as great a part in building up that Empire as England itself (applause)...

THE RESOLUTION—"That, inasmuch as the governing classes of England have made the Coronation an occasion for boasting before the world of the unity and solidarity of their Empire, we, the Parliamentary representatives of five-sixths of the Irish people, whose native Legislature has been by base and fraudulent methods suppressed, more than half of whose population...

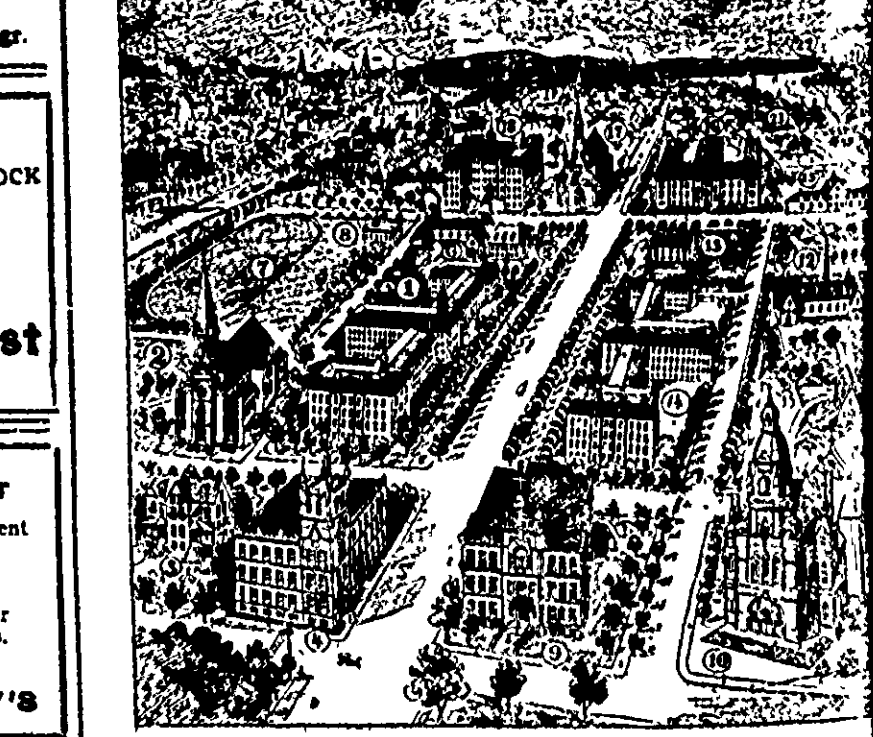
