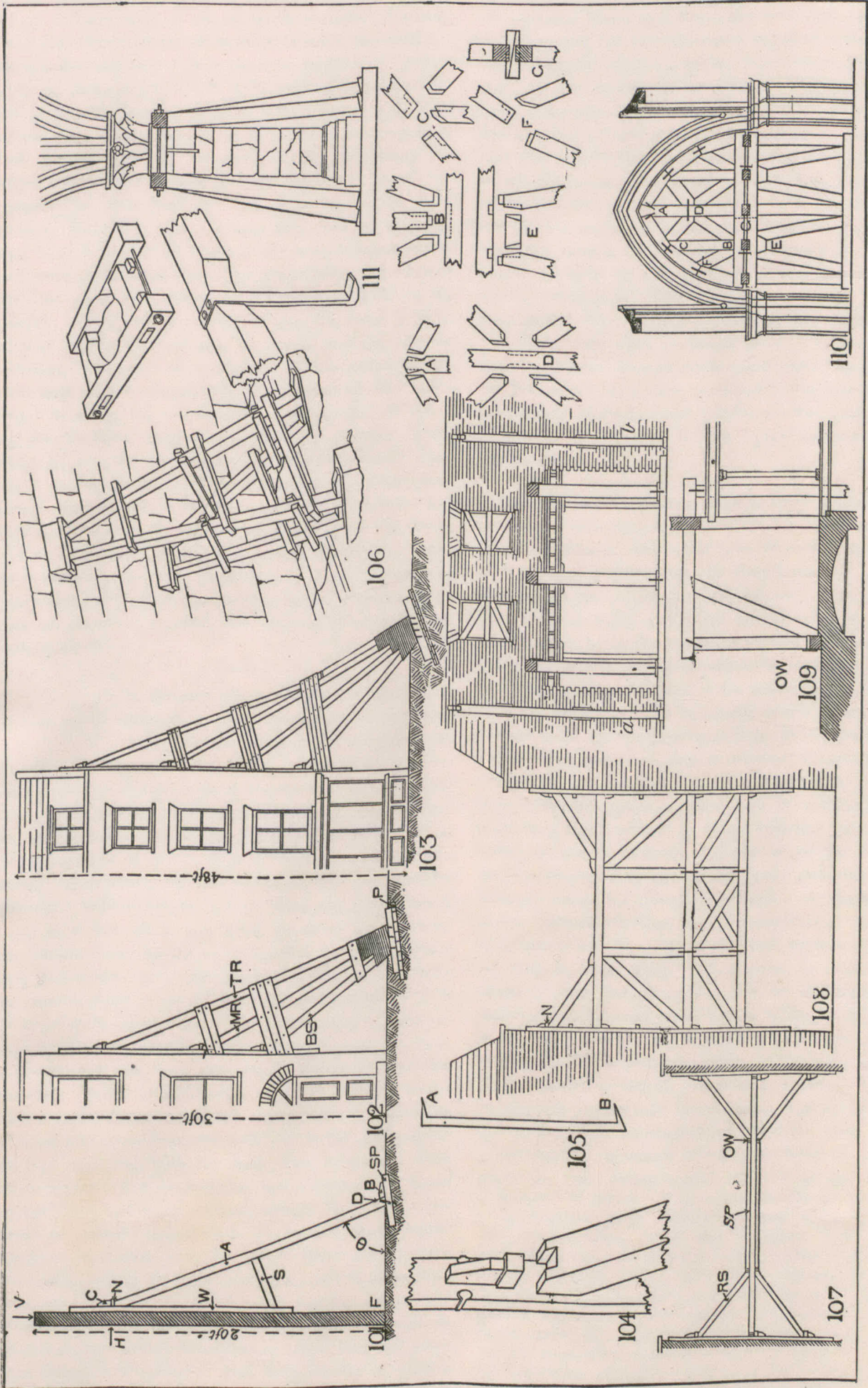




SHORING AND STRUTTING.
