

usual fees upon the said letters patent for the remainder of the term of eighteen years from the date thereof, and may grant and issue to the said George Leonard Williams the certificate of payment of fees provided by *The Patent Act*, and an extension of the period of the duration of the said letters patent to the full term of eighteen years in as full and ample a manner as if application therefor had been duly made within six years from the date of the issue of the said letters patent. 5

Any person who has, within the period between the fourteenth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight, and the extension hereunder of the said letters patent, acquired, by assignment, user, manufacture or otherwise, any interest or right in respect of such improvements or invention, shall continue to enjoy the same as if this Act had not been passed. 10 15
