C A P. XLIV.

An Act to exempt Vessels in the Newfoundland Trade from the Provisions of an Act, passed in the last Session of Parliament, for regulating Vessels carrying Passengers from the United Kingdom.

[3d May 1804.]

HEREAS it is expedient that the Regulations contained in an Act, passed in the Forty-third Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, An Act for regulating the Vessels carrying Pass- 43 G. 3. sengers from the United Kingdom to His Majesty's Plantations and Settle- c. 56. ments abroad, or to Foreign Parts, with respect to the Number of such Passengers, should not be applied to Vessels going to or returning from Newfoundland and the Coast of Labrador, having Persons on board concerned in the Trade and Fishery thereof; and it might be very prejudicial to the said Fishery and Trade, if the Provisions of the said Act should be enforced with regard to such Vessels: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That nothing in the said A& shall be Recited A& deemed and taken to apply to any Ships or Vessels, for which a Clearance Vessels car-
