and we his report suggested that in such cases as the present it would be well for the Visiting Superintendent to prepare the Rules and Regulietions m' draft so that they might be submitted to the Super intendent general before they were frially hassed by the trube in Conneil, after which they could be confirmed by the Evernor in Conneil.
