The Appointments & removals
of Officers.

The crown has power of appointment of
ministers according to conventions etc. &
it has power to remove them when
they have ceased to enjoy the confidence
of the commons, or far had conduct
which may subject to policy of masters
then they must either abandon that office
or retire. In the latter case, the crown
has to fit a ministry to hold the same
minis & if this cannot be got a dissolution
will may be given.

The crown has command of land
and naval forces. This power lies entirely
in Govt. by his concurrence, to exercise
it by advice of ministry. By Mallet & Co.
