The remaining documents required, I am not at present able to furnish, as they do not appear to be on file in this Department; but the Indian Superintendent at Manitoiwaning has been requested to examine the records of his office, and if his search results in the discovery of the missing papers, you will be furnished with copies as soon as possible. These latter papers are described in the clauses 1 to 3 inclusive, of the Hon. Oliver Mowat's letter of 16th October 1891, a copy of which accompanied your letter to me of the 21st October.
