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Ottawa, July 18, 1910.

Sir,

The Department is in receipt of a communication from two of the Indians of the Poplar River Band, in which they express extreme dissatisfaction with their present teacher, Mr. Jones. They complain that he neglects his duties; keeps school very irregularly; does not issue rations and medicines carefully and makes private use of them, even going so far as to sell them.

No report has been received on this school for a considerable length of time and I have to ask you to look carefully into these complaints when you visit the reserve this summer and report fully to the Department.
