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grant can be continued for all such pupils so engaged.

The principal is to make the necessary arrangements regarding the hiring out of the boys who are 15 years of age and over. The wages earned by the boys should be paid to the principal and he should hand all sums he receives in wages over to the boys who earned it and receive a receipt from them. He should give the names of the boys so employed outside the school the wages received and the receipt from each of them should be forwarded to the Department.
