Reinstatement

- 213.(1) Where a Selective Service Officer directs or requests an employed person to accept other employment under this part and notifies the employed person's employer that such direction or request is made pursuant to these regulations, and the employed person thereupon accepts such employment, the provisions of The Reinstatement in Civil Employment Act, 1942 shall apply mutatis mutandis to the reinstatement of such person upon the termination of the work which he has been directed or requested to accept.
- him pursuant to an order made under these regulations, the provisions of The Reinstatement in Civil Employment Act, 1942 shall apply <u>mutatis mutandis</u> to the reinstatement of the person who has been laid off or discharged when the Director certifies that such person is no longer required for essential work.

Appeals

this part shall be final unless by notice in writing filed in the local office within seven days from the day the decision is made a person aggrieved thereby appeals to the Director or some person designated by him for deciding such appeals, in which event, the matter shall be reconsidered by the Director or such other person and the decision on such appeal shall be final.
