3. General Manager's Visit to London & Paris

3.1 BBC & ITA General Manager reviewed his activities in London & Paris. General organization of BBC has remained the same but staff has grown. Union problems being experienced & advice of CBC was welcome. BBC has expressed its intention not to compete with ITA but rather to explore new areas. It does not appear that plans for a second BBC television network will be proceeded with. ITA staff now numbers some 800 & future looks bright.

3.2 BBC-TV Technical Quality Quality of image is remarkable & ENG to investigate.

3.3 London Office Office has moved to new quarters in Langham. Means should be sought to make staff feel more closely related to main CBC body.

3.4 Paris Office Rep has no permanent office & is sharing with D. LaChance. Planning to visit Canada in near future; MGMT asked that series of meetings be organized to determine exact scope of responsibilities.

4. Unoccupied Leased Premises MGMT suggested pre-planning could avoid waste of funds resulting from unoccupancy of rented premises while undergoing alterations.
5. TV Network Extensions ENG informed that orders in council had been approved for extensions by Bell Telephone to Swift Current, Red Deer, Matane & for French network to Three Rivers. Firm quotations received from Railways for network service to Harmon Field.
6. Attendance at General Mgmt Meeting MGMT reviewed list of those expected to attend; list is composed of all who normally attend Mgmt Cttee meetings, regional directors, directors of television, directors of radio & directors of network programming. Heads of divisions to advise MGMT on additional attendance. J. J. Trudeau to confirm arrangements with regional directors.
7. American Funds COMPT raised matter of claim received from Motion Pictures Distributors Inc. COMPT to follow up & advise all concerned on proper procedure in dealing with American distributors.
8. Santa Claus Parades CB will take up with ONT Ron Poulton's item in connection with Kitchener not being included in coverage.
9. CBC Symphony Tour CB following & to take up with G. Waddington.
