Mr Commissioner Shaw: You said something about the Indians being stopped from hunting?

Witness: I dont see why the Indians are stopped from hunting for their own use or from selling meat. We dont kill deer and sell it, it is only for our own use.

Q. You may kill deer for your own use at any time in the year provided it is a male deer over one year old, that is you can get a permit from the Government Agent or from the Chief Game Warden. You can get a permit to kill a male deer for your own use at any time of the year, so long as that deer is one year old.

A. The Provincial Government got the hunting ground where we used to go on. That is, they have a game reserve here. They took a big place, and now there is no place for us to hunt. We want you to fix this so that it will be open to us for hunting all the year round.

Q. Well you cant hunt on the Government game reserve?

A. They took up a small piece at first and then they enlarged it to cover the whole mountain.

Mr Commissioner McKenna: Are there any mountain sheep on Sheep Mountain?

A. Yes, there is always a lot of sheep there.

Q. How many miles big is this game reserve?

A. About 30 miles from Reserve No. 1. It is our own hunting reserve that we want.

Mr Commissioner Shaw: And you want to go there to hunt?

A. Yes, all the Indians that are here used to hunt over there a long time ago. There used to be good hunting around the reserve, but so many whites have come in that there is no hunting now.

Q. Have you any school here?

A. No.

Q. Do you send any of the children of this reserve away to any school?
