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J. G. LEMARCHANT.

*By His Excellency Sir JOHN GASPARD LEMARCHANT,  
Knight, and Knight Commander of the Orders  
of St. Ferdinand and of Charles the third of  
Spain, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in  
and over the Island of Newfoundland, and its  
Dependencies.*

**W**HEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands Prorogued until SATURDAY the *Sixteenth* day of *November* instant; And whereas I think fit further to Prorogue the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY until THURSDAY the *Twenty-third* day of *January* next ensuing.

I do therefore, by this my Proclamation, further Prorogue the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY until THURSDAY the *Twenty-third* day of *January* next; *then to meet for the dispatch of business.* And of which all persons concerned are required and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.

GIVEN under my Hand and Seal at the Government-House at St. John's, in the aforesaid Island, the Fourth day of November, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty, and in the Fourteenth Year of Her Majesty's Reign.
