TREACHERY WAS THE DEATH OF THE MERRY ROBIN HOOD

The Daring Greenwood Bandit was Taken Sick at a Nunnery-Highland Annals Are Full of Such Stories-Nana Sahib Will Always Stand Out as an Execrable Figure in British

Ever since the days when Judes received the thirty pieces of silver a the price of his Mester's betrayal, a peculiar stigma has always attached to the man or woman who gives another up to an enemy, or who induces that other, by a show of friendly intention, to lay aside his armour of defence. The betrayer! The taker of blood-money! There is no term more approbrious no character so despised of all honest men. And it makes but little difference to the scorn in which the inence to the scorn in which the in-former's trade is held, whether the betrayed be some exiled prince or poli-

trayed be some exiled prince or political refugee, or an ordinary dangerous criminal whose capture is eminently desirable in itself.

It seems a fairly well-established historical fact that the famous outlaw. Robin Hood, die I by treachery in the Priory of Kirklees, in Yorkshire, as is stated both in an early ballad called "A Lyttel Geste of Robin Hood," and in a latter poem on the same subject.
