ART COLLECTIONS

Viscount Lascelles Using His Influence to Keep Treasures in England

London, June 27.-Viscount Lascelles, husband of Princess Mary, is now lending his influence in an effort to prevent the old masters in British art collections from being bought up by American millionaires. Lord Lascelles also thinks that owners of mansions who set apart certain sections of their houses so that the public can view their art tragsures should receive some abstement in taxes.

Under the great pressure of taxation, Lord Lascelles told members of the National Art Collections Fund, a number of persons are finding themselves confronted with the necessity of disposing of their priceless art works to American millionaires.

According to statistics already published in the New York Herald, America has taken a toll of more than \$40,000,000 worth of art objects through London since the war. The Government has found itself unable to devote the necessary large sums of money to buying up works of art which owners have been forced to put on the market.

Viscount Lascelles said: "The country finds itself at this moment in such a position that a number of great houses no longer are occupied by their owners; who are put to a considerable expense for their rates and upkeep if they allow the public the benefit of seeing them.
