Newport News, Virg., March 27 .-Rumors last night that the German auxiliary cruiser Prinz Eitel Fried- Killed The Cock-a-Doodle-Doo," which rich was planning to put to sea in an effort to run by the hostile warships on guard off the Virginia Capes, caus ed a stir at Fort Munroe, and all the gun crews in the garrison were called to their stations.


