More About Those Milk-and-Water
Men.

Who Have Earned Unenviable Notoriety
in Haldimand—Inspector Miller
Bury—Eleven Patrons
Fined.

During the past two weeks Mr. S. B. Miller, inspector for the Western Dairy-
men's Association, has been visiting some
of the cheese factories in Haldimand
county and (as already briefly stated in
Advertiser's columns) has been successful
in bringing to justice a number of patrons
who have been tampering with milk. The
cases proven are similar to those already
published. The following are the names of
parties fined and the amount of the fines:
Patrons of Alismack cheese factory. Be-
fore Squire Shipman, of Smithville:

John Bowman, Gainsborough township,
Lincoln county, admitted the charge of
diluting milk with water, and was fined
\$10 and \$40 costs.

Henry D. Miller, Caistor township,
pleaded guilty to taking the cream of the
milk. Fined \$10 and costs.

John Black, Caistor township, was
charged with skimming milk, and was con-
victed. Fined \$15 and \$8.05 costs.

David Vaughan, Gainsborough township,
pleaded guilty to watering milk, and was
fined \$10 and costs.

Richard Hensley, Gainsborough township,
pleaded guilty to watering milk, and was
fined \$10 and costs.

John B. Becker, Gainsborough township,
was convicted of sending milk that had been
both skimmed and watered. Fined \$10 and
costs.

Patrons of the Attercliffe Station factory.
Before Police Magistrate Taylor, of Dunn-
ville:

Henry Waters, Moulton township, Hal-
dima county, a former cheese manu-
facturer, pleaded guilty to skimming milk,
and was fined \$5 and costs.

Daniel Harrington, Moulton township,
pleaded guilty to watering milk. Fined \$5
and costs.

Archibald Angle, Moulton township,
pleaded guilty to watering milk. Fined \$5
and costs.

Frederick Kleugender, Moulton town-
ship, pleaded guilty to taking cream off
milk, and was fined \$5 and costs.

Kasper Houser, Moulton township, was
charged and convicted of sending milk that
had been both skimmed and watered. Fined
\$5 and costs.

In these cases, as well as in all the cases
prosecuted by Mr. Miller this season, the
fines imposed by the magistrates have not
been at all keeping with the enormity of
the crime. If the magistrates thoroughly
understood the law in such cases and the
nature and means of the offense they
could not conscientiously allow so many of
the patrons convicted of tampering with
milk to escape without fining them to the
full extent of the law. If the fines imposed
would not be so many people given to send-
ing adulterated milk to our cheese fac-
tories.

he was eminently successful. Having
procured a license, Rev. Mr. Elliott was
asked to pronounce the young couple man
and wife, which he did with neatness and
dispatch. The bride had been engaged to a
young Thameville man.

Rev. George Kennedy, who, through al-
leged indiscreet behavior, was dropped from
the ministerial roll of the Methodist
Church, is an applicant for charity at the
hands of the Ingersoll town council. He
wishes to be sent to the House of Refuge.
He has just issued a pamphlet in which he
tells his story. "By committing a wrong,

which I withdrew, like the heathen to whom
