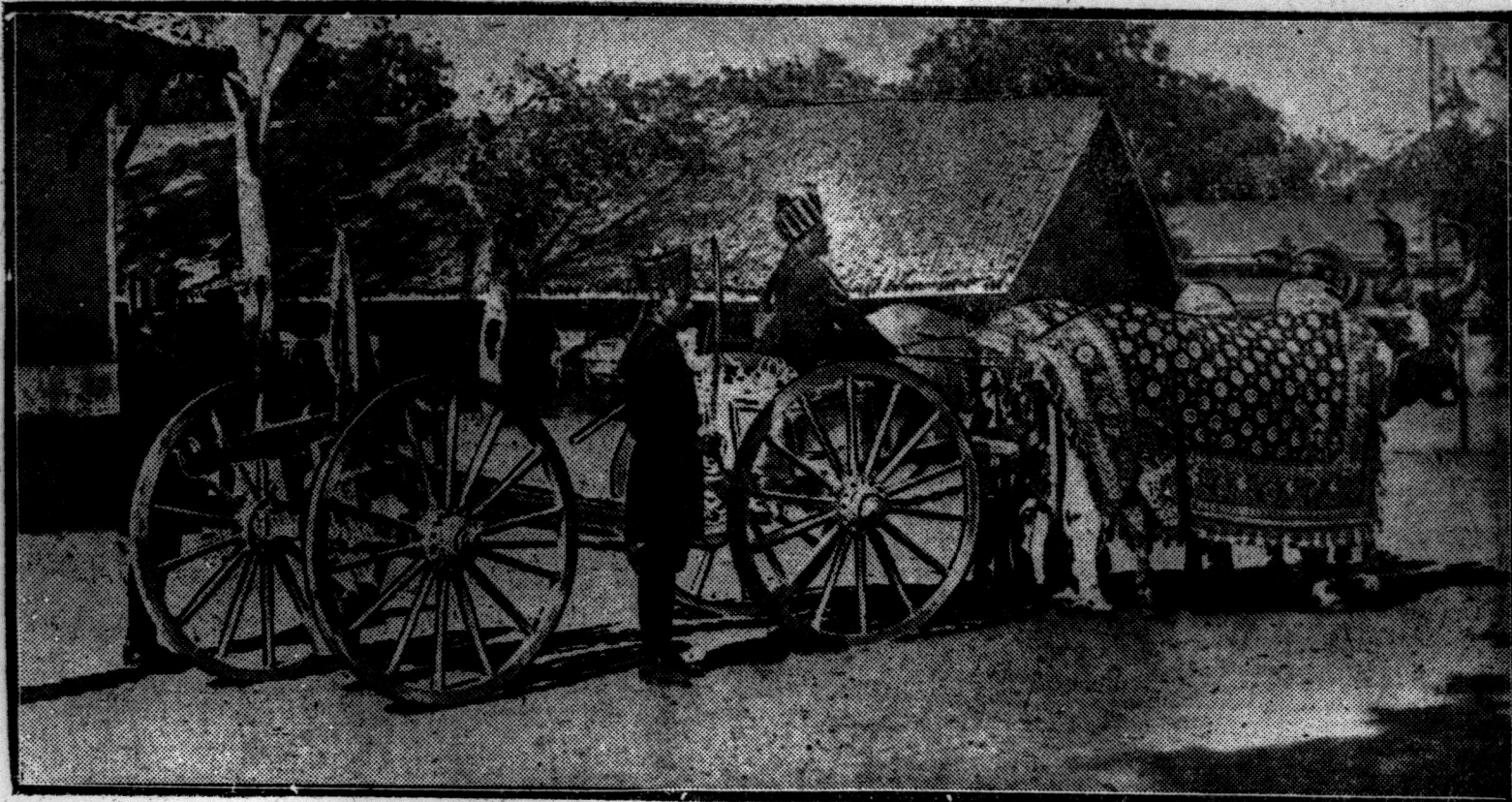

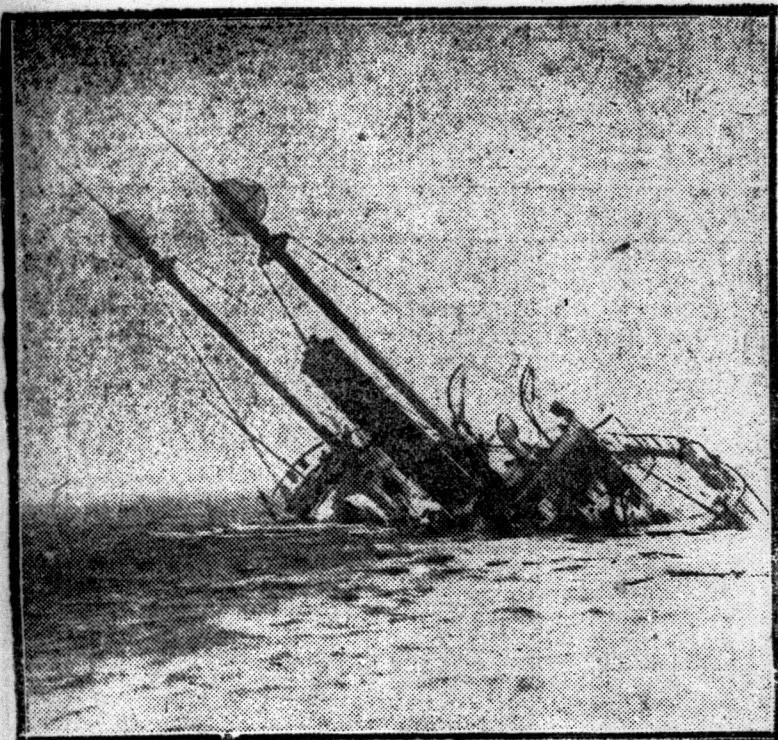
Not a parcel passes in or out of the occupied Ruhr territory without being thoroughly examined by French soldiers.

Relief ship No. 90, aground and half submerged off the Atlantic coast. Efforts to salvage her have failed so far.



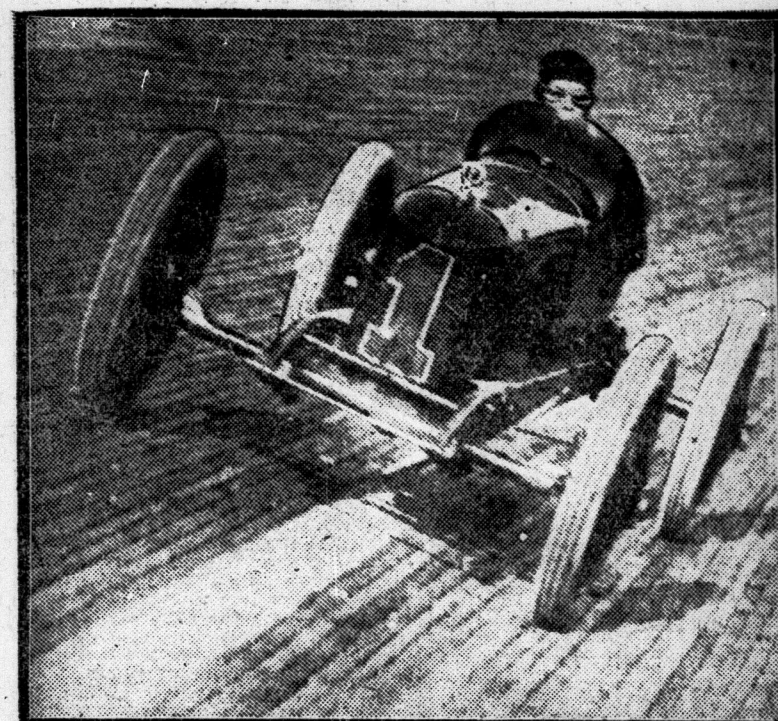
Captain Thomas Lamphier, commander of an air squadron which is attempting to fly from San Antonio to the Virgin Islands.
