A kind of reciprocal compensation thus occurs, causing the vegetation of isolated bacilli to remain so extraordinarily resistant, as, for instance, in legs and scrofulous glands. In such cases the bacilli generally extend only to a part of the cells, which, then, with further growth, assume the peculiar form of risen cells, or giant cells.

It is here in looked at such changes that the effect of the remedy appears. No bacilli have appeared in their sputum for the past three months, and their physical symptoms have gradually and completely disappeared.
