

COLT STAKES.

FOR PRODUCE OF 1876.

Conditions: \$100 each, play or pay, for colts and fillies foaled in 1876, bred and owned in the Dominion of Canada, to be trotted in September, 1879, on a day and track to be named by a majority of the parties entering for such stake; mile heat, 3 in 5, in harness; Dominion Rules. Entries to be made with F. STINSON, Esq., St. Catharines, on or before July 1st, 1877, and to be, with name of sire and dam, sex and color of each, entered \$25 to accompany nomination. Balance of money to be paid as follows: \$25 on or before July 1st, 1878, and \$50 on or before July 1st, 1879. If five start the money to be divided in the proportions of 50, 30 and 20 per cent to first, second and third horses; if more than five start, money to be divided in proportions of 40, 30, 20 and 10 per cent to first, second, third and fourth horses.

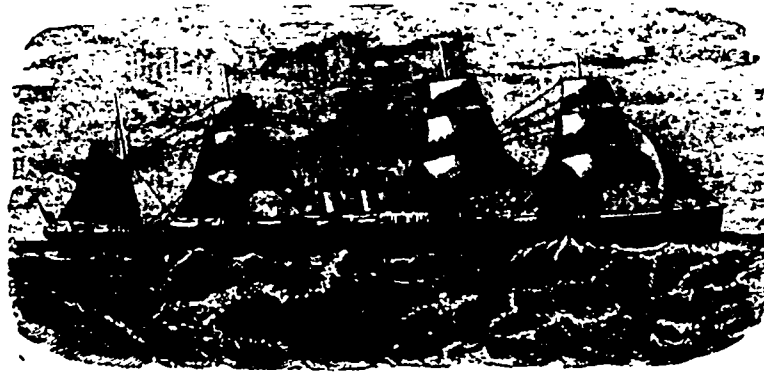

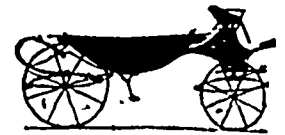
