

INTERNATIONAL JUDICIAL COOPERATION

Canada is actively engaged in international judicial cooperation with other states in civil, commercial, criminal and administrative matters. Cooperation exists in such areas as service of judicial documents, taking of evidence, authentication of documents, estates, extradition and family matters, including reciprocal enforcement of maintenance orders and international parental child abduction.
