PRIME MINISTER'S SPECIAL ADVISORY TEAM TO HOLD TELECONFERENCE FROM SUDAN

The Prime Minister's Personal Representative for Africa, Ambassador Robert Fowler, Canada's Special Envoy for Peace in Sudan, Senator Mobina Jaffer, and Senator Roméo Dallaire will hold a teleconference for members of the Canadian media on Friday, November 18, 2005, from Sudan.

The Special Advisory Team was created by Prime Minister Martin earlier this year as part of an expanded contribution by Canada to support international efforts toward peace and stability in Sudan. The team arrived in Sudan on November 11, 2005, to determine ways in which Canada can assist in reaching a peace agreement for Darfur, to observe the African Union Mission in Sudan and assess Canada's contribution to the mission, and to consult with the Government of Sudan.
