Budget, 3583. The budget a timely and very concise review of the whole financial situation in Canada; failure of Liberal party to take any action to meet depression in 1928 and 1929; warnings by Sir Henry Thornton in 1928 and Mr. Dunning in 1930; revision of the tariff in 1931; granting of bonus of five cents a bushel on wheat in 1931, 3584; Mr. Motherwell's attitude towards the wheat bonus; guarantee of \$15,000,000 to the Saskatchewan wheat pool; relief measure to grant seed to farmers of Saskatchewan put through house by closure; action of government in supporting the wheat market in fall of 1932; increase in our export trade as a result of Imperial conference agreements, 3585; shipment of dressed turkeys to Britain in December, 1932; beneficial effect of agricultural stabilization fund on our exports; action of Mr. Motherwell in 1923 in providing for the importation of renovated butter; reciprocal trade relations with the United States, 3587; appointment of a royal commission on banking and monetary conditions; the railway question; effecting public economies; attacks on the government for assistance to the province of Saskatchewan, 3588
