Mr. Baldwin: Mr. Chairman, I rise on a point of order. There is the usual government omission here. It may well be that in the bill Your Honour has called, the number of the act may be set out. However, in the bill given to the Leader of the Opposition and myself on behalf of our party, there is no number. Obviously there will have to be an amendment, because the Chair has received the bill in its present form. If necessary, I imagine the committee will be prepared to give unanimous consent to allowing the government to remedy its error and put in the number of the act.
