is sufficient material removed, a great quantity of gunpowder will be placed inside, and the upper crust will be blown to atoms, and the channel of the river be improved. This great event will take place on the centennial celebration of the nation's independence in 1876, and I suppose is intended as part of the programme which will be gone into. I don't know that these will be circulated in Britain, and in case they should not be so, I have been thus particular to call attention to it before I leave these shores, so that those who wish to be present at such an imposing and startling exhibition will know when to cross the Atlantic to visit the shores of the New World.
