

## BY-LAWS.

I.—In the absence of the President and Vice-Chairman of Meeting, President from any meeting a chairman shall be elected by the majority of those present.

II.—In all cases of ties in voting the chairman shall have the casting vote.

III.—No member under 21 years of age shall be eligible for the office of President, Vice-President or Treasurer.

IV.—All officers shall continue in office until their successors have been duly installed, which shall be done as soon as convenient after their election.

V.—If any officer absent himself from three successive regular meetings, his office may be declared vacant by a vote of the Association.

VI.—If, upon reconsideration, a candidate for membership that has been rejected be admitted, no notice shall be taken of such rejection.

VII.—A proposition for membership cannot be withdrawn except at the meeting at which it was submitted.

VIII.—If any member change his place of residence he shall notify the Recording Secretary of the same within two weeks, otherwise notices directed to his address as appearing in the books shall be considered valid.
