Death of David O'Shea In China.

David O'Shea, son of Mr. J. J. O'Shea, assistant editor of the Catholic world magazine, died in Nawchwang, Ohina, October 25, aged twenty-one years. The deceased was the youngest of three brothers, all of whom have lived in China for some years past. Henry O'Shea, one of the brothers, is editor and proprietor of the Ohina Gazette, published in Shanghai. The youngest boy, who has just died, was in the service of the Imperial Maritime Oustoms. He was greatly esteemed both at home and abroad, and his death is sincerely regretted. The blow is especially hard for the father of the young man, who was so many miles away from his son when the last . 1mmons came.
