lasting. It is easier to learn five new things than to unlearn one old. This applies specially to the pronunciation of Proper Nouns.

The admirable rule laid down by Lord Sydenham should always be our guide:—

"Be sure you are right and then go ahead."

The questions hitherto published in connection with this subject are added; they afford to teacher and pupil some idea of the style and difficulty of the examination for which they are preparing.
