NEW TELESCOPE FOR ARMY

Enables Gunner to See Enemy While
Invisible to Them.

WAKEFIELD, Mass., Aug. 16.—After
years of patient experimenting and
improvement, in the course of which
his ideas have been at times held up
to ridicule, Dana Dudley of this town
has just had the satisfaction of having
his "pan angle" telescope adopted by
the war department of the United
States.

The invention is simple in its con-
struction, yet, it is said, may revolu-
tionize modern warfare. It consists of
reflecting lenses so arranged at angles
in a tube that persons or objects above
or below and on all sides may be view-
ed from a place of concealment.

The device as constructed for use in
warfare is arranged so that even on
disappearing guns or guns used in
trenches and fired from any point in-
visible from the exterior the operator
may ascertain the location of the en-
emy, target or other objective point
without exposing himself.

WRECK IN SARNIA TUNNEL

Traffic Delayed for 12 Hours—Broken
Coupling Caused It.

SARNIA, Aug. 16.—(Special.)—By the
breaking of a coupling in a long freight
train which was being hauled out of
the Sarnia tunnel, the big tube was
blocked completely for nearly 12 hours.
Passenger and freight trains were badly
delayed, and several had to be sent
around via Windsor and across on the
car ferries.

This is the first accident of any im-
portance since the tunnel was electri-
fied, and there were fears that the
deadly electric fluid might break loose
and result in some casualty, but the
current was promptly cut off and the
wrecking crews worked freely. Traffic
was resumed shortly before 6 o'clock
to-night.

The damage to the tunnel will be
slight, but loss will be entailed thru
the destruction of several carloads of
freight.

AUSTRALIA'S NAVY

Men and Officers Will First Be Pro-
vided by Britain.

LONDON, Aug. 16.—(C. A. P.)—The
scheme of naval defence agreed to by
the Australian representatives and the
admiralty is described as completely
satisfactory to Australian national sen-
timent. The Australian fleet does not
pass automatically under the control
of the authorities during war, but will be
placed at the disposal of the British
navy, and, in consequence, will be re-
cognized as a part of the British
fleet, and will be under a central
control. Ample provision of officers,
manned by the British navy, will be
made for the time the imperial navy
may supply officers and men. No
dreadnought will be given, the money
being spent on cruisers.

AVIATOR CURTIS HURT

Wind Catches His Aeroplane and It Is
Seriously Damaged.

RHEIMS, France, Aug. 16.—Guy Cur-
ties, the American aviator, met with
an accident during a trial flight to-
day.

The accident was due to a large gust
of wind, catching the aeroplane cross-
wise and causing it to strike the
ground hard on its side. It is stated
that the aeroplane was damaged great-
ly, and that repairing it possibly will
be a long operation and even may pre-
clude Mr. Curties' participation in the
first days of the meeting.
