NEW OCEAN RECORD

Royal Edward Clips Two Hours Off Previous "Best Time."

QUEBEC, June 15.—(Special.)—Two hours have been clipped from the Canadian trans-Atlantic record from dock to dock. The Canadian Northern's new triple-screw turbine steamer, "Royal Edward," which left Bristol at 8 p.m. Thursday last, docked here to-day at 10 p.m., beating the best previous performance of any Canadian steamer by two hours. It was confidently expected here that she would dock at noon, as a wireless dispatch received this morning from Captain Roberts, her commander, reported the passing of Father Point at 8.10 a.m. Shortly after passing Father Point the "Royal Edward" encountered dangerous fog banks and was compelled to proceed from that point on at reduced speed, otherwise a more spectacular reduction of the record would have been effected.
