Real choice light butcher cattle were steady, but very few of this class were on the market, the majority being in poorer quality and about 10c lower in price.

Cows—Real good cows were also steady, but the bulk were not first-class and were mostly low to average.

Bulls, canners and cutters, stockers and feeders and milkers and springers were steady.

Lambs were 25c higher. Sheep were steady. Calves were 10c to 15c lower.
