TO TRAVELLERS;

For the information of Travellers between Windsor and Parisborough, &c. MHE Parrisborough Packet sails regularly between Windsor and Parsborough every week, from the 1st April to Christmas, vi.: ft leaves Parrsborough on Monday, wind and weather permitting so as to be at Windsor on Tuesday; and will sail from thence the first high water that happens at or after eight o'clock in the morning of that day; the Packet frequently goes twice or three times a week when business requires it.

Time of going through the Falls.

THE Falls are level (or still water) about three hours and an half on the Flood, and about two hours and an half on the ebb, which makes it passable four times in 24 hours, about 10 or 15 minutes each time. No other rule can be given, as much depends on the floods in the river St. John, and the time of high water or full sea, which is often hastened by winds, and in proportion to the height of them
