YESTERDAY'S STORM.

A severe electrical storm in the province yesterday did much damage to property and one life was lost, that of Mrs. Bourque of Fox Creek. A house and barn owned by Emerson Steadman and John Hoar were damaged by lightning at Fox Creek. A barn owned by George Hopper, Little River, Albert county, was destroyed. The storm was felt at Fredericton but not so severely as in other parts of the province. A barn said to be owned by Abraham Bridges near Fredericton, was destroyed causing much loss to stock, hay and farm implements. The storm hit Nova Scotia heavily and at Springhill barns belonging to Charles Mason were destroyed with the contents. On Charles Moore's farm a few miles from Kentville a man was struck by a bolt of lightning and made unconscious. The transforming station of the Dominion Steel Corporation at Sydney was destroyed and several houses damaged.
