MILKING COWS USED TO TEACH BOYS ARITHMETIC
St. Louis, Mo., Feb. 8.—Boy inmates at Bellefontaine Farm, the municipal industrial school, who are studying dairy farming are taught arithmetic by milking cows.

Instead of problems about discounts and invoices, the boys are required to figure in detail the amount of money earned by each cow in its care. The cost of grain, silage, hay, and beet pulp fed to the cow is balanced against the value at wholesale prices of the milk which each animal produces.
