

to enlarge, in a judicious and careful manner, the language of our praise, and that a decided advantage will have been gained by the Church, when it has found to its satisfaction a collection of hymns at once chaste and forcible, and thoroughly pervaded by the spirit of the Gospel.—These hymns we shall rejoice to use in connexion with the Psalms of David, remembering, and employing always with superior interest, the songs which God himself has given, and seeking only in our human endeavours to bring out more manifest and clear the glorious truth that the Son of God has died for sinners, and that this is the only ground of our hope, and our acceptance with God.
