At Farnham, Que., on the 5th of July 1942, after having been warned to proceed for service overseas, with intent to avoid so proceeding, absented himself without leave from 2359 hours, 5th July 1942, from C.I.T.C. A-12, C.A., until apprehended by the Canadian Provost Corps, Sherbrooke Detachment, M.D. 4 at Magog, Que., at 0115 hours on the 28th December, 1942; thereby missing the draft. Cost of apprehension and return to his unit \$3.66.
