A Centennial. Major Harvard, of Bath, celebrates his hundredth birthday—A Long and Busy Life.

BATH, Maine, March 16.—Today Major Thomas Harvard, of Bath, celebrates his hundredth birthday. Letters received from him from Brooklyn, N. Y., his home, state that he is in good health and happily conscious of the century which has passed over him.

Major Harvard was born in Bordenville, Me., March 15, 1788. In early manhood he came to Bath and began to work on the ship yards. For years he was one of Bath's most prominent shipbuilders, occupying the wharf at the extreme north end of the city known as the "Harvard yard." The place is now unoccupied and the old shop is rotting and there is little left of the busy days of 60 years ago.

Some 20 years ago Major Harvard retired from active business as one of our well-to-do citizens. His summers he still passes in Bath and his winters in Brooklyn.

Major Harvard received to-day many congratulations and tokens of esteem from the many friends who join with the community in celebrating this notable event.
