1. In connection with the above, further investigation in this matter has failed to bring out further evidence.

2. A charge of manalaughter was laid by the writer before Magistrate A. U. LeBel of St Paul, in Bonnyville against Jack MARTIN, date of hearing was set by Magistrate LeBel to 2 P.M. Saturday October 15th 1938 at Cold Lake, Alta., summons to defendant and to some witnesses was served on the 8-10-38.

3. Witness, Olaf AASEN and Miss Herbertha MARTIN have left Cold Lake and are now resident of Edmonton. Olaf AASEN lives in the New Alberta Rooms this being situated on top of The Edmonton Furniture Exchange St unknown. Miss Martin at 14604, Stony Plain Road, living with her parents, both are attending school. Altho this evidence would be require should this charge be send to higher court, it is not absolutely essential for this preliminary hearing. Miss Martin's evidence is of hearing a "THUD" she was sitting in the box of the truck with her back to the driver's cab on the driver's side, being enclosed in the box, her evidence is not of which side of the road that the truck was travelling at the time of the accident. Should it be thought necessary to call these witnesses attached hereto are summons for each with one original.

4. The two member of this detachment will be given evidence at this preliminary hearing, and also in view of paragraph three of the Assistant Deputy Attorney General letter I would respectfully request that Solicitor from the Attorney General's Dept be appointed to conduct this preliminary hearing and from which first hand knowledge to the department of this case standing would be available.
