AMSTERDAM, Ohio. — With the recovery of twenty bodies from the burning Y. and O. Coal company's mine here, it is believed that all the miners who were entombed for more than three days, have been accounted for.

The bodies of James Gray, foreman, and A. Hyniski were brought out later and thirteen bodies were located still later. All the miners were said to have perished from suffocation.

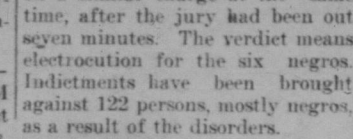

SIX NEGROS GUILTY OF MURDER
HELENA, Ark. — Rapid progress marked the trials of cases growing from the recent race disturbances south of this city, one colored man being convicted of first degree murder after eight minutes of deliberation by a jury, and five others suffering a verdict of guilty on a similar charge at the same time, after the jury had been out seven minutes. The verdict means electrocution for the six negroes. Indictments have been brought against 122 persons, mostly negroes, as a result of the disorders.

NEED MORE CLOTHING IN DRAUGHT AREAS
As a result of the activities of the various chapters of the Daughters of the Empire, the Red Cross and the Homemakers' clubs, sufficient clothing has been gathered and sent out by the Saskatchewan bureau of labor to protect 30 families in the drought-stricken areas of the province from the rigors of winter.

Up to Monday the bureau had received from the women's organizations applications for clothing from 190 families consisting of 975 persons. Clothing to the extent of 14 boxes, 13 sacks and 11 bundles has been received by the bureau and these have been sufficient to clothe 30 families of 159 persons.

It will be seen that a great deal more clothing is yet required, and this is needed immediately if suffering is to be prevented, severe weather having already set in. The greatest need, it is stated, is for underclothing for women and children.

An appeal has reached the bureau from a lady teacher of Meunast school, near Schmidt, asking for contributions of boots to enable some of the children in her district to attend school. She encloses a list of the sizes of boots and ages of the children. "They come long distances," says the teacher, "and need warm things for feet and bodies. All these people have large families and there are many little ones. Please send us what you can. I will see that all things are fairly distributed."

It is pointed out that all worn clothing donated for needy settlers should be forwarded through the organizations mentioned or to the Normal school, Regina.
