CLOSING COTTON LETTER.

New York, Aug. 31.—The cotton
market this morning opened firm, ad-
vances ranging from 11 to 12 points.
Sentiment was very much unsettled,
with local traders against an advance,
but still apprehensive of further gains
before the bureau as a result of the
recent private estimates of crop de-
terioration. The Journal of Commerce
published this morning indicating a
condition of 72.6, a decline of 14.3
points for the month. The average
of the deterioration indicated by four
reports issued by this journal, Miss
Giles, A. Norden & Co. and the Na-
tional Ginners Association is 15.15.
People that the government figures
will approximate this decline, espe-
cially in view of the pressure that has
been brought on the bureau to re-
duce a report "more favorable to cot-
ton producers." The impediment
to the government figures, followed by
the three day holiday deterred consid-
erable short selling and caused a fair
volume of short covering, but in the
absence of demand was counteracted
by liquidation on the part of certain
large holders who evidently feared
that the country would sell on a
bullish estimate. The relative dull-
ness developed in the afternoon seem-
ed to indicate a pretty well evened
out market so far as the scattered out-
side interest was concerned and all
things considered the response to re-
cent bullish news has been disap-
pointing to the average holder.
