PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that a Bill will be presented for enactment at the next session of the Provincial Legislature the object of which is to amend the "Saint John City Assessment Act 1918" in the following particulars:
(1) to provide that real estate to the amount of \$500. for a female who is compelled to earn her own living, where the total amount of such real estate does not exceed \$5,000, shall be exempt from taxation under the said Act.
(2) to provide that when an estate of a deceased person has been wound up and the income therefrom becomes payable to the beneficiaries of the deceased, the amount thereof in writing must be immediately given to the Chairman of the Board of Assessors.
(3) to provide that all companies, corporations or individuals doing business in the said City and who transfer their business to some other company, corporation, individual or individual, shall be liable to be assessed in the succeeding year on the income received during the year in which said business was transferred.

Needling Assistance.
Halifax, March 9. The United Shipping Board steamer Nococheia, which was yesterday sending out a general call for assistance, reporting herself short of fresh water, without steam, drifting and using the mechanical fog whistle, has, according to latest advices to the Shipping Board here, another Shipping Board steamer standing by ready to render assistance. The Nococheia gave her position as 340 miles from St. John's, Nfld. She is a steamer of 9,000 tons dead weight and left Port Arthur for Rotterdam on February 21st.
