**CORRIGAN** Reg. No. 16941, ex-S/Sgt. Ernest Hugh Corrigan, 67, died May 10, 1998, at Ottawa, where he was born March 3, 1931, and joined the Force Apr. 16, 1951. Upon completion of training at "Depot," Corrigan was posted to "B" Division, Nfld., at St. John's and Stephenville and was transferred to the following locations: Sept. 1, 1955, to "A" Division, at Ottawa; Aug. 1, 1969, to "H" Division, N.S., at Halifax, retiring July 31, 1973. Corrigan was promoted to corporal May 1, 1961; sergeant Nov. 1, 1964; staff sergeant May 1, 1967.

**DAVIDSON** Reg. No. 17578, ex-S/Sgt. Lowell Alistar Davidson, 66, died March 20, 1998, at Campbell River, B.C. He was born Jan. 18, 1932, at Yellow Grass, Sask., and joined the Force Feb. 28, 1952, at Winnipeg, Man. Upon completion of training at "Depot" and "N" Divisions, Davidson was posted to "E" Division, B.C., at Qualicum Beach, Nanaimo, Maillardville, Prince Rupert, Powell River and Campbell River, retiring May 1, 1980. He was promoted to corporal May 1, 1962; sergeant Feb. 1, 1969; staff sergeant Feb. 1, 1974. His son, Reg. No. 34531, Cst. T.A. Davidson, is presently serving at Parksville, B.C.

**DOWICH** Reg. No. 19978, ex-Sgt. Stanley Dowich (formerly Downorowicz), 60, died July 12, 1998, at Mountain, Ont. He was born Apr. 5, 1938, at Montréal, where he joined the Force May 23, 1957.
