
BILL.

An Act to amend, and repeal part of, an Act passed last Session, intituled, "An Act to amend the Common Law Procedure Act, 1856, and to facilitate the remedies on Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes."

WHEREAS, in the present depressed state of the Province it is Preamble. considered it would be oppressive towards a large class of the inhabitants and injurious to the commercial, agricultural and mechanical interests thereof, should the summary remedy for the recovery of Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes, provided by the fourth, fifth, sixth and seventh Clauses of an Act passed in the last Session of the Provincial Parliament, intituled, "An Act to amend the Common Law Procedure Act, 1856, and to facilitate the remedies on Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes," be allowed to take effect on and after the first day 10 of July next. Therefore, Her Majesty, &c.

1. The said fourth, fifth, sixth and seventh Clauses of the said Act shall be and the same are hereby repealed. Sections 4, 5, 6 and 7 of 20 Vic., ch. 57, repealed.
