Sir,-

I have to inform you that a communication has been received from Mr. Scobie Logan, asking for permission to take gravel from a portion of land on the Caradoc reserve, for the purpose of making a cement foundation for a memorial stone to his youngest son, who was killed at the front. In connection with this application, I may say that you may give a permit to Mr. Logan to take the quantity of gravel required for this purpose, on the distinct understanding, however, that the consent of the Indian owner of the land and of the lessee, if any, is obtained, as well as the consent of the Band.
