12th, In the case of Lot Ash and Wife (the latter, from the State of New York ^{only} last year) to be separated upon the List.

13th, The names of ^{the} ~~six~~ ^{seven} members, ^{were} ~~are~~ submitted for removal from the List, as they are resident for seven years in Indian Territory U.S. The Council say yes, with the promise, that if ~~either~~ ^{either} return at any time, they may be restored upon application.

Some additions in connection with the new fence surrounding the Council House grounds, are recommended, and, will be mentioned at a future Council.

Upon the report of the Council, in regard to the property of the late Moses Lohu, will be the subject of a special letter.

Seth Bumbery who fled the country to avoid arrest for a grave offense in the killing of another Indian, after some years, returned, - was taken and tried, - convicted of manslaughter, and sent to the Penitentiary for three years, having returned, he is restored to the List by the Council.
