In the Senate, June 22, 1899 Mr. Sproule's bill striking out the word "unduly" was discussed. It was further discussed on July 17, 1899.

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July 17, 1899. In the Senate second reading of Mr. Sproule's Bill to amend the Criminal Code.

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Note --

Draw attention to the fact that combinations are liable to arise in connection with the necessities of life primarily.

Mackenzie Bowell, in speaking July 17, 1899 on the proposed amendment to the Criminal Code said: "You are enacting a law which like some others will be very harsh in its character if literally interpreted and will therefore become a dead letter." He pointed out in particular that the penalties were very severe.
