



Ottawa April 28th, 1909.

Sir,-

I beg to inform you that Mr. J. S. Dennis, Canadian Pacific Railway Co., Calgary, Alta. has been given permission to have necessary surveys made in the Blackfoot Indian Reserve in connection with a large irrigation project which the Railway Company has in hand. The Company is to pay for damages if any that might be caused in the execution of the survey and please note especially that no work of construction is to be proceeded with until the Right of way has been duly arranged for. Kindly inform the Indians and instruct them not to molest the surveyors in the execution of their work.
